Publishers can be great at selling books – at Folio we concentrate on what it takes to sell *your* book. We partner with publishers and other top-notch professionals to enhance your visibility and sales.

We're also excited about shaping the *future* of publishing. As the internet, technology, and culture change, publishing is rapidly evolving – and we're committed to staying on top of the curve.

Forward-Thinking Promotion & Support

At Folio we have a full time *Marketing Director* on staff to help our authors and their publishers promote their books to as wide an audience as possible. Typically our marketing efforts begin by developing a "wish list" with the publisher to inform likely readers, reviewers, and/or special groups (including book clubs) about an author's work. For example, we launched a blitz targeting Civil War enthusiasts (contacting more than two-thousand Civil War bookstores, museums, round-tables, and re-enactors across the U.S) for the *New York Times* bestseller WIDOW OF THE SOUTH by Robert Hicks.

We have, on-staff, a *Director of Speaker Services*, who arranges speaking and reading engagements for our authors.

We also have associations with *Licensing Agencies* to make the most of authors' brands and talents and to sell subsidiary products and explore spokesperson deals.

We also have the capacity to create our own databases to reach specific target audiences. To promote our authors with works of biblical-themed fiction, for instance, we targeted mailings to the Jewish community through more than 100 newspapers, 850 synagogues, 250 community centers, and Jewish Book Festivals across the US.

We actively use new media to reach a broader readership - Internet chat, social networking, multimedia book promotion, and interview sites are just some of the avenues we explore. Our relationship with top videographers enables us to provide cutting-edge author media material at a discounted rate.

At Folio, we often have one-on-one brainstorming sessions with authors to uncover and exploit promotion opportunities – locally, nationally, and globally – working long past the date of publication to continue to publicize our authors' work.
